If your student-athlete makes a team, payment of \$150 is required before the first contest or the student may be held out of competition.

HS Cycling League: Ava has been representing Monument Academy and D38 at the Colorado High School Cycling League this fall racing Junior Varsity. (For many schools in D38 and D20 that do not have enough riders for their own teams, riders wear either the Highlanders or Palmer Ridge jerseys.)

If you were unfamiliar with the Colorado High School Cycling League, it is a league of cross-country mountain bike races with teams competing from across Colorado and a few teams from Wyoming and New Mexico.

Over four races, Ava has been on the podium twice and most recently finished fourth overall in the Crystal region.

She has qualified for the state championships in Glenwood Springs on October 18-20th. In attendance there will be over 160 schools with roughly 1000 of the best riders racing in eight divisions.
